Itinerary

Day.1

Mumbai - Beijing

On arrival, you will be met and transferred to hotel by the local guide. After a good rest in a comfortable hotel TVH recommended, enjoy dinner at an Indian Restaurant. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day.2

Beijing

Depart from hotel in the morning to visit the biggest public square in the world, Tian'anmen Square conquers you with its grandeur at the first sight. Then you are led to Forbidden City. It is the imperial palace for 24 emperors during Ming and Qing Dynasties and the biggest ancient architecture complex in the world. You walk in the museum to see with your eyes, to touch with your hands and feel with your hearts. In the afternoon, you continue your trip to Summer Palace. Having the largest royal park and being well preserved, it was designated, in 1960 by the State Council, as a Key Cultural Relics Protection Site of China. Containing examples of the ancient arts, it also has graceful landscapes and magnificent constructions. Dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day.3

Beijing

In the morning, drive 75 km to visit the Great Wall at Juyong pass which is the symbol of China and the wisdom of Chinese people. It is very unbelievable that Chinese succeeded in building such a great architecture with simple tools in ancient time. Then visit Jade Factory and Ming Tombs (Changling Tomb), consisting of 13 tombs of the emperors of the Ming Dynasty after the capital was moved from Nanjing to Beijing. This is unique as it is the only huge palace made of camphor wood. If time enough, you will have a short stop and take photos in Beijing Olympic Park, where you can see the outside view of the National Stadium - Bird's Nest and National Aquatics Center - Water Cube. Dinner at Indian Restaurant.

Day.4

Beijing - Xian

In the morning, you will visit the Liulichang which is a famous district in down-town Beijing that is known for a series of traditional Chinese stone dwellings housing that sells various craftwork, artistry and antiques. It is one of Beijing's traditional old quarters. Then visit Da Shi Lan, one of Beijing's most famous old-fashioned streets, has a history dating back 570 years. It was built in 1430, the 18th year of Emperor Yong Le's rule during the Ming Dynasty. Da Shi Lan is 375 meters long and is home to 26 shops from nine types of trade. Later you will take the flight to Xi'an, on arrival Xian, check-in to the hotel. Dinner at an Indian restaurant.

Day.5

Xian

Have a nice breakfast at the hotel. This morning depart for a full day tour with a visit to the China's Richest historic area, which is recognized by the UNESCO as the eighth wonder of the world, amazing Museum of the Terra Cotta Warriors which is very famous for the great underground army of the First Emperor of China, buried together with him 2200 years ago and discovered only in 1974. It is the most significant archaeological excavations of the 20th century. Then you will visit Special art lacquer work shop. Free time you can shop at Ancient Style street. Dinner at an Indian Restaurant. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day.6

Xian - Guilin

In the morning, you will visit the City Walls. It is the most complete city wall that has survived in China as well as one of the largest ancient military defensive systems in the world. Bid Wild Goose Pagoda a well-preserved ancient Building and a holy place for Buddhists. Afternoon take flight to Guilin. Dinner at a Chinese restaurant.

Day.7

Guilin

Depart from your hotel in the morning and begin your Half - Li River Cruise which is the masterpiece of nature. The crystal water, picturesque mountains, peaceful farm field, hard-working fishermen and wondering water buffaloes compose a poem of Guilin scenery and life. Under the blue sky, your river boat is floating on the river, making you in an unreal dream. After you disembark the Western-influenced town Yangshuo, you can roam at the West Street, it earns its name since almost every one in West Street can speak fluent English and every restaurant or bar offers menus in several languages. You will fall in love with the town at the first sight. Moreover, it is flanked by small shops and vendor stands selling different kinds of souvenirs, which are the best gifts for your friends and relatives. Late in the afternoon, you will return to Guilin. Dinner at a Chinese restaurant. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day.8

Guilin - Shanghai

Have a tasty breakfast at the hotel. Set out on a half-day visit to Elephant Trunk Hill. It is a huge rock formation of an elephant by the confluence of the Yang and Li rivers, which looks as if its trunk, dipping into the water. The next wonder to visit is Reed Flute Cave, is named after a certain kind of reed grown near the carve gate, which is used for making a flute instrument. The natural beauty of a large amount of stalactites and stalagmites, with their endless variety of remarkable scenes in the cave could undoubtedly evoke breathless admiration from you. Thus, the cave is highly praised as the Huge Art Palace of the Nature. Then take afternoon flight to Shanghai, check-in to the hotel on arrival. Dinner at an Indian restaurant.

Day.9

Shanghai

You will be taken to see a Buddhism shrine -Jade Buddha Temple, located in a crowd of Shanghai City. It is named for its two bejeweled white jade Buddha. Carved from a whole piece of white jade, the sitting jade Buddha statue is translucent with a solemn expression, displaying the excellent skill and extraordinary art of Chinese people. Yuyuan Garden has many scenic courtyards decorated with baroque rockery, pools and flora that are all connected by corridors and passageways. Then you will visit Pearl Factory. The shopping trip will begin in Nanjing Road which starts at the Bund and runs westward, with People's Square in the middle. Renown for its bustling and modernization, Nanjing Road earns its reputation as the 'First Commercial Road in China', which is the good shopping heaven for your trip as the same as the Fifth Avenue in New York and Avenue des Champs-Elysees in Paris. Some of the traditional food and handicrafts of Shanghai can be found here. Then we come to the Bund. The renowned waterfront district is the city's most famous landmark. The word BUND is of Anglo-India origin meaning embankment on the waterfront. It is also the popular site to enjoy the night view of the city. Standing at Pudong New Area at the east side of Huangpu River, Oriental TV Tower was completed on October 1, 1994. The tower has a height of 468 meters. With multi-functions of sightseeing, catering, shopping, amusement and accommodations, this tower has become the symbol of the city and a popular tourist attraction in Shanghai.

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Sightseeing

Tiananmen Square

It has great cultural significance as it was the site of several important events in Chinese history. Outside China, the square is best known for the armed suppression of the pro-democracy June 1989 Tiananmen Square protests.



Forbidden City

The Forbidden City is a magnificent ensemble of buildings surrounded by a rectangular area in the center of Beijing, the capital of China. Nowadays it is perfectly preserved and allows to see its architecture with precision.



Summer Palace

Summer Palace, an Imperial Garden in Beijing. The Summer Palace in



Beijing – first built in 1750, largely destroyed in the war of 1860 and restored on its original foundations in 1886 – is a masterpiece of Chinese landscape garden design.

Great Wall at Juyong pass

The pass is one of the three greatest mountain passes of the Great Wall of China. The other two are Jiayuguan and Shanhaiguan (passes). Juyongguan Pass has two 'sub-passes,' one at the valley's south and the other at the north. The southern one is called "Nan (pass)" and the northern is called "Badaling".



Ming Tombs

Ming Tombs (Thirteen Tombs of Ming Dynasty) 50 kilometers (31 miles) northwest from Beijing City, at the foot of Tianshou Mountain, is the Ming Tombs Scenic Area, aka Thirteen Tombs of Ming Dynasty, where lie the mausoleums of thirteen emperors of the Ming Dynasty (1368 - 1644).



Liulichang

A district in downtown Beijing that is known for a series of traditional Chinese stone dwellings selling various craftwork, artistry, and antiques. It is one of Beijing's traditional old quarters.



Da Shi Lan

Terra Cotta Warriors

The major cultural achievement of Qin Dynasty Art (221-206 BCE) and one of the greatest archeological finds in the history of Chinese art, The Terracotta Army (also known as the "Terracotta Warriors") is a massive collection of terracotta sculpture consisting of 8,000 clay warriors and horses



Big Wild Goose Pagoda

The pagoda was built in 652 during the Tang Dynasty and originally had five stories, although the structure was rebuilt in 704 during the reign of Empress Wu Zetian and its exterior brick facade renovated during the Ming Dynasty.



Li River Cruise

A Li River Bamboo Raft Trip. Taking a bamboo raft along the river is a more traditional way to travel. You can get closer to the water but it is affected by the weather. It is a different way to see the beautiful scenery of the Li River, and the route is shorter than the ones used for the cruise boats.



Elephant Trunk Hill

Elephant Trunk Hill (Xiangbishan) is the landmark of Guilin. Located in Elephant Hill Scenic Area (Xiangshan Park) at the confluence of Taohua River and Li River, it has been a famous tourism destination since the Tang Dynasty (618 – 907). The hill looks like a giant elephant drinking water from the river.



Reed Flute Cave

The cave got its name from the type of reed growing outside, which can be made into flutes. Reed Flute Cave is filled with a large number of stalactites, stalagmites and other rock formations. Inside, there are more than 70 inscriptions written in ink, which can be dated back as far as 792 AD in the Tang Dynasty.



Jade Buddha Temple

The Jade Buddha Temple is a Buddhist religious building, located in Shanghai, China. It is famous for its Buddha statues made from jade. These statues are believed to have been brought to the temple from Burma by a Buddhist monk. The temple was founded in 1882 CE to house them.



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
